IMPORTANT NOTE:

Please make sure that all hospitality requirements for the artist are provided before, after and during the gig.

Catering Requirements

Drinks:

- Fresh squeezed juices (**no bottled juices**)
- 2 x bottles of Still mineral water & Coca Cola
- 2 x bottles of Champagne (Bollinger, Taittinger or Ruinart - no Moët)
(please make sure that these drinks are available on stage during Ben Klock's set time)

Food:

- Fresh juice, orange juice or similar (**ready on stage before the performance**)
- Fresh high quality local food. - No festival catering please

Hotel Requirements

- 5* Hotel Junior or Suite with a late check out between 2pm / 14:00 and 4pm / 16:00 (dependant on flight schedule) + double hotel room is required for Tour Manager.
- Breakfast must be included, or room service if the kitchen is closed.
- Free Wi-Fi is essential – any extra costs should be paid when the reservation is made.
- 70€ / \$70 / £60 Budget for non-alcoholic drinks from the room's mini-bar should be included in the hotel booking and has to be paid by the contract partner.

Travel Requirements

- All travel will be booked through our travel agency, Landebahn Travel Service.
- Please make sure that pickups are done by a professional / sober driver
- Any travel arrangements by car, train or airplane need to be in the non-smoking area. Pickups from the airport to the hotel need to be in a non-smoker's car
- Please note: For nearly all performances an additional flight & transfer is required for Tour Manager.
- Train reservations: 1st class (including window seat) reservation

Flights:

- Only business class flights + 1 x eco flight for the tourmanger
- Aisle Seat Reservation (especially for Intercontinental flights)
- Priority Boarding
- Star alliance Airlines
